## **Dear Deputy**

Thank you for your representation. As you will be aware the demand and uptake for the COVID vaccine has to date surpassed the supply available.

On Monday 12<sup>th</sup> April 2021, the Government approved an update to the <u>COVID-19 Vaccination</u> <u>Allocation Strategy</u>. This strategy sets out the groups to be prioritised for vaccination to best achieve the vaccination programme's objectives of preventing serious illness, hospitalisation and death. It is based on clinical, scientific and ethical frameworks produced by the National Immunisation Advisory Committee (NIAC) and the Department of Health. The HSE is rolling out the vaccine programme in line with NIAC guidelines and group 4 - 7 will be managed in parallel. Dates are subject to change given the ongoing supply chain uncertainty.
