"To ask the Minister for Health the amount a company (Cpl Recruitment) is paying each vaccinator per hour and per day; the amount the HSE is paying the company for those vaccinators per hour and per day; and the average number of vaccines each vaccinator administers per day."

Dear Deputy,

I refer to your Parliamentary Question (above) and wish to apologise for the delay in responding. The contract between the HSE and the named company is commercially sensitive. The HSE pays the named company an agreed agency fee percentage mark up on each Vaccinator during their employment as a Vaccinator.

The actual figure per hour and per day fluctuates dependent on the number of contracted hours/days worked by each Vaccinator in each Vaccination Clinic and the Vaccinator's point on the Vaccinator salary scale in line with the clinical experience of that Vaccinator.

The salary for a Vaccinator ranges from €35,000 to €50,500 per annum for a 39 hour week. This is paid on a pro rata basis dependent on the contracted hours per Vaccinator. The HSE pays the named company for the contracted rate of salary per Vaccinator plus an agreed agency fee percentage mark up.

The number of vaccines administered per day by any vaccinator is an operational matter and is governed by the clinical and operational lead at each site.
