Dear Deputy Devlin,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

HSE Estates agreed with the local school Collinstown Park Community College and Dublin & Dún Laoghaire Education & Training Board (DDLETB) on the site location for the Primary Care Centre (PCC) in Rowlagh in return for a new purpose built multi-functional room that is to be attached to the PCC. On that basis HSE Estates proceeded to complete design works including an enabling works package. In addition, planning permission, the fire safety cert and the disability access certificate have all been granted.

There has been delays to the project due to the issue regarding the transfer of the site to the HSE from the Department of Education. HSE Estates are still in discussions with the Department of Education to progress the project.
