Thank you for your correspondence received on 10th May, 2021 in relation capacity at Clifden District Hospital.

I can confirm that an amalgamated unit for long term and short term care for Clifden is included in the HSE Capital Plan. There are currently an average of 9/10 patients being accommodated at Clifden District Hospital. It is envisaged that when the new amalgamated hospital is complete it will provide 40 beds to facilitate both long and short stay patients.
