The number of WTE Urology Nurse specialists at CHI at Temple Street is as follows:

Jan 2018- September 2018- 1.9 WTE October 2018- April 2019 -2.9 WTE May 2019 to present- 4.0 WTE

There are no plans to increase numbers of full-time nurse specialists in Urology service at Temple Street.
