"To ask the Minister for Health the extent to which HSE email systems remain unavailable due to the recent cyber-attack; and if he will make a statement on the matter."

Dear Deputy Pringle,

Email services are fully available in areas which had Microsoft Outlook, the two areas which used Lotus Notes are migrating to Microsoft Office. Email system are now fully functional for outlook users and are now treated as 'business as usual'. Lotus notes users are over 97% successfully migrated to outlook. The Remote Hubs commenced in the following Hospitals Louth, Monaghan, Navan, Cavan, Sligo, Letterkenny. Hubs continued until 22<sup>nd</sup> October to finalise the migration. Lotus notes migration has moved to a 'business as usual' mode of operation- In addition, the Lotus Notes archive mail is now available for all users. Microsoft Office archives are being restored on a user request basis. The HSE ICT Service Desk is available to manage any issues that may arise with emails on an ongoing basis.
