PQ 53799/21-Deputy Richard Bruton: To ask the Minister for Health if his Department has sought to enunciate general principles which should apply in relation to patient visiting opportunities; if particular considerations are suggested in circumstances in which the patient's vulnerability may call for greater family support; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Bruton,

Many thanks for your representation.

Infection Prevention and Control (IPC) practice is critical to the safe operation of acute hospital and residential care services. The focus on the rigorous application of IPC measures is increased in the context of a public health emergency such as the current pandemic, but must be balanced with regard for the needs of patients for access to people who are important to them. Vaccination of the majority of the population has been associated with a striking reduction in the risk of severe COVID-19 in patients, residents and staff resulting from exposure to the SARS-CoV-2 virus in the healthcare setting. There are however still significant risks in particular for many of those who use our services.
