"To ask the Minister for Health the number of persons availing of the fair deal scheme by the primary care centre and primary health network catchment area in County Cork currently in tabular form".

Dear Deputy Gould,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The Nursing Homes Support Scheme, also known as the "Fair Deal", provides financial support to people who need long-term nursing home care. Under this scheme, individuals make a contribution towards the cost of care and the Health Service Executive pays the balance. The scheme covers approved private nursing homes, voluntary nursing homes and public nursing homes.

Categorisation of information by primary care centre/primary health network catchment area is not available at present. The tables below detail the number of persons in Cork availing of the Fair Deal Scheme in both public and private units, broken down by Local Health Office (LHO).
