The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and I outline the position as follows.

Primary Care response:

Social Care Disability response:

Midlands Louth Meath Community Health Organisation (MLM CHO) Laois Disability Services can confirm that the Spraoi Centre is fully operational.

Laois is reconfigured into Children's Disability Network Teams (CDNT) Networks 11 & 12. CDNT's have been established under the National Progressing Disability Services for Children and Young People programme of change.

There are now two (2) teams in Laois namely Spraoi CDNT Network 12 and Barrow CDNT Network 11 both currently operating out of the Spraoi Centre. The two (2) teams are currently undertaking a review of all the services and at this present time there are 850 children registered with the Spraoi CDNT Network 12 and 300 children from Laois registered with the Barrow CDNT Network 11.
