Re: PQ 56670/21 "To ask the Minister for Health the steps he is taking to address the lack of available home support service carers in an area (details supplied); the number of persons in the area who have been approved for home support but whose service has not commenced due to lack of carers; and if he will make a statement on the matter." Details Supplied: Dublin Bay North

Dear Deputy O'Callaghan,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

In Dublin Bay North there are currently 41 people who have been approved for a home support service but for whom care cannot be sourced.

Community Healthcare Organisation Dublin North City and County (CHO DNCC) operates the nationally agreed tender (2018) for the provision of home support services. A total of 16 agencies are approved as Tier 1 providers and a further five agencies approved as Tier 2 providers. Tier 2 providers are only utilised if the Tier 1 providers are unable to provide a service within HSE specified timelines. We are currently engaging with our providers to address capacity issues across the area including Dublin Bay North.

We are also in the process of identifying home support providers who are not on the current tender with a view to adding further providers to increase capacity. From our meetings with providers we have been advised a number of home support workers have left the industry in recent months citing the challenge of providing this service during the pandemic. In light of this we are engaging with our providers regarding the recruitment of new staff into the workforce.
