PQ 56997/21: To ask the Minister for Health the number of full-time equivalent nurses in each hospital, former LHO or smallest geographic unit; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Carthy,

I refer to your recent parliamentary question in relation to staffing numbers part of which was forwarded to the Health Services Executive (HSE) by the Department of Health for direct reply.

The Deputy will be interested to note that, Employment levels at the end of October 2021, show there were 131,126 whole-time equivalent personnel (equating to 150,034 individuals) directly employed in the provision of Health & Social Care Services and of which 31.4% (41,128 WTE or 47,174 individuals) were Nurses & Midwives. The majority of nurses & midwives are employed in Acute hospital services with the remainder employed across other care groups (including Community Health & Wellbeing, Mental Health, Primary Care, Disabilities and older persons together with national services such as Heath & Wellbeing, Cancer Control Service, Clinical Design & Innovation, Environmental Health, Human Resources, National Screening Service and so on. Details of the WTE and headcount by care group for Nurses & Midwives are as follows:
