The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and outlined the position as follows.

The primary care building will provide accommodation for two separate GP practices. There will be five GP treatment rooms together with one practice nurse room in one and four GP treatment rooms together with one practice nurse room in the second practice area.
