"To ask the Minister for Health the number of dentists with medical card contracts in each of the CHO 4 sub sections in each of the years 2016 to 2021, respectively in tabular form; and if he will make a statement on the matter."

Dear Deputy Sherlock,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The Primary Care Dental Services team provides dental treatment to eligible children, medical card holders, special needs clients and others in the care of the HSE at various locations throughout Cork and Kerry.

Children under 16 years of age are treated in HSE dental clinics and adults are treated by private dental practitioners contracted to the Health Service Executive under the Dental Treatment Services Scheme (DTSS). Unfortunately, in recent months there has been a significant reduction in access to the DTSS for medical card holders in Cork and Kerry as dentists who hold contracts under DTSS have either resigned their contracts or are not accepting new patients at this time.

Currently there are fewer dentists participating in the DTSS scheme than there were before the Covid -19 pandemic. As a result, there is an increased demand for care on the private dentists who continue to operate the scheme. In addition many dentists who remain operating the Scheme are not taking on new patients.

A more long term solution will require engagement at a national level between the various stakeholders.
