Please note the information provided is based on claim data which has been received by the Primary Care Reimbursement Service (PCRS) from Community Pharmacists and includes items reimbursed by PCRS only. Whilst the report reflects the reimbursement cost presented against pharmacy claims for those with GMS and DPS eligibility, expenditure for patients receiving products privately or sub-threshold DPS cannot be determined by PCRS.
