To replace / install signage throughout the hospital

To install new signage at Front Hospital Entrance

Pop up Tipperary University Hospital banners

Large display stand

The cost of hospital flags with logos - €700

Staff Costs ongoing as staff member x 2 released to complete work - ongoing

Summary costs at this time = €10, 738.14
