Question: To ask the Minister for Health the percentage breakdown of Covid-19 vaccination uptake in each county; the number of persons in each county that have availed of the vaccine; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Burke,

I refer to the above Parliamentary Question which has been referred by the Minister for Health to the Health Service Executive for direct response.

As at 8th November the overall uptake rate amongst the total eligible population (12+) for dose 1 (partially vaccinated) is 92.1% and fully vaccinated is 90.5%. Ireland has the highest uptake rate in the EU and is currently 1st in the EU for those fully vaccinated.

We have only recently commenced producing vaccination rates by county, as there was significant work to ensure that county data was accurately reflected on our system. These are provided through our Health Protection Surveillance Centre (HPSC) which are included in the Appendices for your information.

The HSE Vaccination Programme have been using this data within our Uptake Improvement Group to identify marginal improvements in some counties. This includes walk-in clinics, local pharmacy promotional campaigns, campaigns with difficult to reach groups and a range of communication initiatives to support increased uptake.

We are also aware in the border counties that there will be people resident in the South who have been vaccinated in Northern Ireland. While we have been working closely with colleagues in Northern Ireland on this it is currently not possible for accurate data on the numbers involved to be provided to us.

I trust this information is of assistance to you.
