Dear Deputy Ó Murchú,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and I outline the position as follows.

CHO 8 are piloting the roll out of the InterRAI System, referred to in your correspondence and are using existing resources to do so. A national recruitment campaign is due to commence to employ 130 staff for the national roll-out of the InterRAI system.

In addition a recruitment campaign has been undertaken in CHO 8 to recruit Home Care Support Assistants, with anticipated start dates in November 2021.
