Dear Deputy O'Dea,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

Response:

The National Clinical Programme for Rheumatology (NCPR) have advised that local arrangements are made where appropriate for access to dietetic services in both the acute and community setting. The NCPR have dietetic representation on the clinical programme working group to address the provision of a dedicated dietetic service in the long-term objectives of the NCPR.
