Dear Deputy Wynne,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Questions, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

Response:

HSE Acute Operations has developed a Food, Nutrition and Hydration Policy for Adult Patients in Acute Hospitals. This Policy provides a framework for a standardized approach to food and nutritional care provision by all staff. It encompasses recommendations on nutritional screening and promotes a patient centered approach to delivery of services. It aims to improve the patient's experience of food and nutritional care in hospital.

A toolkit to support local implementation has also been developed to provide guidance to support implement the policy recommendations and to strengthen current food, nutrition and hydration practices. The toolkit has been developed to support all members of the multidisciplinary team to implement the policy recommendations.
