**Re PQ 47215 21:** To ask the Minister for Health the percentage of healthcare expenditure which was generated by private, voluntary and out-of-pocket contributions for each of the years 2018, 2019, 2020 and to date in 2021; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Cullinane,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. Your PQ above has been referred to me for response.

I spoke to Daniel Keating of your office on 12/10/21. Daniel confirmed that your request centers around the breakdown of the HSE budget, distinguishing between government funding and funds from other sources (among those mentioned by Daniel on the call – private patient income, car parking fees etc.)

The data is compiled on an annual basis, therefore data for 2021 is not available at this time.

For each year 2018, 2019 and 2020 the HSE Annual Report and Financial Statements (AFS) contain an Analyses of Overall HSE Income and the notes to the AFS break each element down in more detail.
