The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

The below table outlines the expenditure for each of the years 2017 to 2020. It should be noted that this growth in expenditure includes the following:

- Expenditure relating to NSP development funding received
- Covid related expenditure of €21.2m in 2020
- Pay restoration expenditure as a result of agreed pay reversals (ie Lansdowne road agreement) including consultant contract agreement payments
