To ask the Minister for Health the number of persons attending PrEP clinics at present by the Dáil constituency they live in, in tabular form; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Deputy Brady,

Thank you for your question to the Minister for Health, which was forwarded to my office to respond to you directly.

The provision of HSE funded, free PrEP to those at substantial risk of sexual acquiring HIV was first introduced in November 2019.

Since then, 6,216 individuals have been approved for PrEP, including 848 individuals in Q1 2022.

The number of people attending PrEP services is not available by Dáil constituency.

PrEP is currently available via a number of public STI clinics, a number of GPs and private STI providers <https://www.sexualwellbeing.ie/sexual-health/prep/where-to-get-prep/>.
