Dear Deputy Hourigan,

Thank you for your PQ above, which has been forwarded to me for direct reply.

In general terms the HSE Cross Border Directive (CBD) allows for a patient to choose to access healthcare which they would be entitled to receive in the public health system in Ireland. I can confirm that no patients accessed healthcare under the CBD for cancer treatment not available in Ireland.

The table below provides the data requested in relations to patients who travelled abroad under the HSE Treatment Abroad Scheme.
