Name of Org.	Mainstream Social Inclusion Funding Amount	Year funding suspended/discontinued	Reason
Transgender Equality Network Ireland	€80,000	2021 (under review in 2022)	Failure to comply with National Financial Regulations.
North Inner City Local Drug & Alcohol Task Force	€224,473	2021 (under review in 2022)	Instructed by Dept. of Health due to governance issues.
Addressing Drug & Alcohol Problems Together (ADAPT)	€546,864	2017	Company ceased to deliver service, following review, implementation process and recommendations of ADAPT Board.
Fingal Traveller Organisation	€128,741	2017	Organisation ceased to deliver services.
