To ask the Minister for Health if consideration has been given to add glucoRX Aidex continuous glucose monitoring system to the long-term illness scheme; and if he will make a statement on the matter. -David Cullinane

Dear Deputy Cullinane,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question (Reference 21036/22), which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

GlucorX Aidex Continuous Glucose Monitoring (CGM) system is currently undergoing review via Procurement for addition to the National Pricing Framework and supply through Aids and Appliances at local level. The GlucorX Aidex CGM sensors are approved in principle for addition to the formal GMS Reimbursement List if and when the equipment (e.g. transmitter) secures a positive recommendation through the national procurement process.
