The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the following Parliamentary Question, which was submitted to this Department for response.

PQ 63063/22

To ask the Minister for Health the number of home care support hours for older persons being provided in each LHO area to date in 2022; the way that this compares to each LHO in 2020; and if he will make a statement on the matter

The Home Support Service is funded by Government to deliver a volume of service each year as approved in the HSE National Service Plan. For 2022 it is expected that 23.67m hours will be delivered to 55,675 people by year end. The Service is a non-statutory one with access based on an HSE assessment of the person's needs, having regard to the available resources and the competing demands for the service from those people with assessed needs. Notwithstanding the significant level of service provision, the demand for Home Support, and its importance as an alternative service to long stay care, has grown considerably over the past number of years.

Latest available reported activity reflects the period to end of October 2022. As of this date, 17,562,809 home support hours were delivered nationally to 56,210 people. In addition, 7 people were assessed and waiting for funding for new or additional home support and 6,125 people were assessed and waiting on care staff to be assigned at that time..

In terms of the requested information, Appendix 1 hereunder sets out the National/CHO/LHO Home Support activity as at the 31st of October 2020 and as at the 31st of October 2022.
