"To ask the Minister for Health the status of the establishment of a primary care centre in Millstreet, County Cork; and if he will make a statement on the matter."

Dear Deputy Moynihan,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

An expression of interest for the development of Millstreet PCC was issued in 2019 and there were Expressions of Interest received from five separate Developers. Unfortunately there was no response to stage 2 of the process by the Developers and it was recommended to re-advertise for this development.

Stage 2 is when a Developer provides the following information;

1. GP Declaration Form

A signed GP declaration form from local General Practitioners, confirming their interest in the Developers proposal (General Practitioners involved should (a) hold a GMS list or (b) assist in servicing a GMS list held by another GP within the practice).


2. Signed Compliance Declaration

A signed Compliance Declaration, stating that prior to proceeding to stage 3 of the process, that the Developer is capable of fulfilling all requirements and that they are still interested in making a Stage-3 submission including a Priced Offer.

The development of all primary care centres is subject to GP commitment and completion of the build to HSE specification.
