Thank you for your above correspondence which has been referred to me for response. The eHealth & ICT Capital plan outlines the planned investment of €130m in digitally enabled change programmes for 2022. There are three categories of investment programmes within the plan:

1. Foundational Infrastructure & Cyber Technology (8 programmes; €59.8m)
2. National Programmes (26 programmes; €60.2m)
3. Transformation priorities (15 programmes; €10m)

I attach an update on each of these 39 programmes (Programme Updates PQ Number 4525_22 _) along with the eHealth & ICT Capital Plan 2022.
