Dear Deputy O'Dowd,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and outlined the position as follows.

Louth Primary Care Ophthalmology Service is currently recruiting staff into the service. The available cohort of appropriately qualified professional staff in the field of Ophthalmology are few in number. We are acutely aware of the need to provide this service to the people of Louth and every effort is being made to fill all vacancies as soon as possible.

Please be advised that at present the Louth Community Ophthalmic Physician is reviewing all referrals and clients should contact either of the main Primary Care Centre in Louth if there is an urgent and immediate need. Contact details as follows:
