To ask the Minister for Health the number of HSE ambulances, rapid response vehicles and motorcycles allocated to County Wexford and available to attend emergency calls in each of the years 2019, 2020, 2021 and to date in 2022, in tabular form.

The National Ambulance Service (NAS) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for response.

Please find below the tabulated responses to your Parliamentary Question up to 31st December 2021. The report for January 2022 is currently being finalised.

Please note that this is not a list of vehicles on duty on a daily basis. It should be noted that all NAS resources are dynamically deployed to calls across the country on a nearest available (to the incident) basis and not on a county boundary basis to respond to incidents as they arise to ensure the nearest available resource responds to emergencies.
