Dear Deputy Hourigan,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

In order to comply with patient safety under Covid 19 guidelines the HSE moved residents from their previous location to Garnish House in Cork City.

The costs associated with the rental of this property is €41,501 per month with an additional cost of €1,887 per month for cleaning services.

The HSE have purchased a property in Carrigaline which is in the process of being converted to provide older person residential beds, once complete the residents currently in Garnish House will be moved to the new property.
