PQ 6839-22 Deputy Louise O'Reilly-To ask the Minister for Health if and the number of the 1,000 treatment courses of the first delivery of the monoclonal antibody, xevudy also known as sotrovimab which arrived in Ireland on 20 January 2022 that have been distributed; and if he will make a statement on the matter

Dear Deputy O'Reilly,

Thank you for your representation.

Sotrovimab is currently being prescribed in hospitals around Ireland to COVID-positive patients who are deemed eligible under the prioritisation list prescribed by the Therapeutics Advisory Group.

As of 18th February 2022, there have been approximately 112 doses of Sotrovimab administered. The delivery of Sotrovimab arrived in Ireland in late January and then was immediately distributed to hospitals. All hospitals in Ireland have access to supplies of Sotrovimab.
