Dear Deputy O'Dowd,

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

I wish to advise you that the information you are seeking is collected through HIPE. As you are aware, HIPE is a health information system, managed by the Healthcare Pricing Office (HPO) of HSE Finance and is designed to collect clinical and administrative data on discharges from, and deaths in, acute public hospitals in Ireland.

Please see attached excel spreadsheet containing the information you requested which is from HIPE and was provided by HPO.

As the 2021 file is an open file and continually added to, the information requested cannot be provided for 2021. The file is due to close the end of March so data should be available in April 2022.

Please pay careful attention to the explanatory notes in the excel sheet and to the list of diagnosis codes.
