The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

A Design Team have recently been appointed to progress the Emergency Department and Medical Assessment Unit project at Mayo University Hospital.

The Design Team are familiarising themselves with the site and the project. It is anticipated the preliminary design will be available by Quarter 2, 2022.

Regarding the CT scanner project, the Design Team are currently reviewing building solutions to accommodate a CT scanner. It is expected a proposed solution will be completed in Quarter 2 this year.
