HSE Capital & Estates are currently undertaking a Design Feasibility Study to determine the best use of the Royal Hospital, Baggot Street site.

Included in the Feasibility Study is the possible retention of part of the site for the purposes of building a new Primary Care Centre and the disposal of the remainder of the site/buildings that are not suitable for healthcare provision.
