The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

There are currently 9 Occupational Therapists (OT) working in Primary Care Services Galway. The breakdown for the number of OT's working in Galway Primary Care Services are as follows;

We also followed up with our Disability colleagues and currently there are 8 OT's working in Galway Disability Services;
