Dear Deputy Munster,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) National Ambulance Service (NAS) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Questions, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The NAS can confirm that an inspection by the Health and Safety Authority (HSA) has taken place at Drogheda Ambulance Base, local NAS management are managing the subsequent follow up. NAS is currently progressing the recommendations by the Health and Safety Authority in order to ensure legislative compliance.

The NAS in conjunction with HSE Estates is progressing the capital estates plan over the coming years which includes Drogheda ambulance base, the final cost is yet to be confirmed therefore we cannot comment at this time.
