To ask the Minister for Health the number of suicide resource officers employed by the HSE; the number of vacant posts; the length of time these posts have been vacant; when they will be filled; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy,

The HSE National Office for Suicide Prevention (NOSP) has been requested to respond to your question above.

There are presently 19 Resource Officers for Suicide Prevention (ROSPs) in position across HSE CHOs nationally. Contact details for these ROSPs and their related areas are publicly available here. https://www.hse.ie/eng/services/list/4/mental-health-services/nosp/resourceofficers/

Further, there are also 4 ROSP posts presently vacant;

- CHO 3 Limerick, Clare, North Tipperary 1.0 WTE vacant since February 2021. Two
 recruitment campaigns for the post were unsuccessful and other options are currently being
 considered.
- CHO 7 Kildare, West Wicklow 1.0 WTE vacant since October 2021 with recruitment process underway.
- CHO 8 Louth, Meath 1.0 WTE vacant since February 2020 arrangements have
 continued in place to ensure service needs have been met during this period. While internal
 appeals processes have affected timelines with regard to the filling of this post to date, HSE
 Midlands Louth Meath remain actively focused on progressing this post through the
 recruitment process as a priority. This will be progressed in early course when this process
 has concluded.
- CHO 8 Longford, Westmeath 1.0 WTE vacant since mid-January 2022 with active progression to temporarily fill this post with a Specified Purpose Contract for six months.
