Dear Deputy O'Connor,

To ask the Minister for Health if he will provide this Deputy with an update on the provision of long-Covid clinics in Cork; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. We have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

The HSE Interim National Long-Covid Model of care (MOC) was finalised in September 2021. The aim of the MOC is to ensure that patients who have recovered from the acute phase of COVID-19 are followed up in a timely and appropriate manner, taking into consideration factors such as disease severity, the likelihood of long term respiratory illness and functional disability. It proposes a three tiered approach to service delivery ranging from patient led self-management, to community and GP led intervention to specialist consultant led clinics.

Specialist clinics are further stratified into Post-Acute Clinics for patients with symptoms up to twelve weeks and Long COVID clinics for patients with symptoms for more than twelve weeks. As part of the MOC deliverables for 2022, there are eight Post-Acute clinics, six Long COVID and a National Neurocognitive clinic.

The South/ South West Hospital Group (S/SWHG) are happy to confirm that Cork University Hospital (CUH) has been identified as a specialist site for the development and establishment of a Post-Acute COVID clinic and a Long COVID clinic within S/SWHG.

In line with national strategy, management at S/SWHG and CUH are in the process of progressing the recruitment of staff to support the development of these specialist clinics with appropriate clinical, rehabilitation and specialist supports. There is a CUH representative on the working groups for the Post- Acute Clinic and Long COVID Clinic who are involved in planning such clinics, preparing national standards, and implementing the MOC. In line with the National MOC this service may be delivered on a single site, across multiple sites or virtually.
