Dear Minister Noonan,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question, which was submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

I have reviewed the matter and the following is the current position.

HSE South East Community Healthcare Disability Services acknowledge the requirement for increasing the available accommodation for the participants of KITE Services and are actively working with HSE Capital & Estates Directorate and HSE Legal Advisors to secure the lease of appropriate accommodation to extend the accommodation for KITE Day Service in Kilkenny subject to the necessary approvals.

It is understood that over the coming weeks the lease commencement date will be confirmed. Once this information is available and if any temporary arrangements are required, the KITE Service Team will liaise with participants and their families with regards solutions such as temporary accommodation and outreach programmes.
