The Health Service Executive has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Representation, which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response. I have examined the matter and I outline the position as follows.

I refer to your recent PQ 23949/22 regarding this matter and wish to advise the status of Side A remains the same, with building works outstanding. A supply issue in with the building materials required to finish the works in Side A has caused the delay in operationalising the service. Contractors for the project have projected these works will now be complete in Q3 2022.
