PQ 38200/22 - To ask the Minister for Health the number of full-time posts allocated to post-acute and long-Covid clinics, by clinic and speciality in tabular form; the number of vacant posts; the number who have taken up posts; and the number that are currently going through the HSE recruitment process.

Dear Deputy,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question (PQ 38200/22) which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

The HSE recognises the need to provide follow up support and care for patients experiencing prolonged signs and symptoms of Covid-19. In response to this it has developed an Interim Model Of Care (MoC) for Long Covid which was finalised in September 2021. The aim of the MoC is to provide a national approach to the provision of services and supports for patients experiencing prolonged symptoms of Covid-19. It sets out a framework for the provision of these services and supports spanning General Practice, Community Services, Acute Hospitals and Mental Health Services. The resultant Interim MoC recommended the development of six Long COVID clinics, eight Post-Acute COVID clinics and one tertiary referral neurocognitive clinic for those with complex neuro-cognitive/neuropsychological symptoms.

Implementation of the MoC commenced in January 2022. At this point, some of the designated hospital sites were already providing Long Covid and Post-Acute services on an interim basis while awaiting recruitment of full staffing as per the Model of Care. They have been established in response to local need and are leveraging existing resources and capacity. The HSE has been working with sites to expand their resources to ensure they can meet the requirements of the Model of Care.

The MoC identifies the resources and personnel required for each of these clinics including infectious disease consultants, respiratory consults, neurologists and additional multi-disciplinary staff to support the clinics. The HSE worked closely with clinicians and senior management at each site to map existing resources against what was outlined within the Model, this identified gaps within existing service provision and informed what additional resources were required. It also ensured that the resources allocated were reflective of what was required within a local context.

Primary Notification Numbers were provided to each of the sites during March and April so that they could proceed with recruitment of the personnel associated with each of the clinics. Recruitment is now underway and the HSE is continuing to engage with Strategic Workforce and Planning and with each of the individual



sites to closely monitor recruitment. Please see appendix 1 for a full breakdown of posts and their recruitment status.
