Dear Deputy O'Rourke,

The total cost of the cyber attack as of 15th July 2022 is €51,845,579.84. The breakdown of costs per year is provided in the table below. The majority of costs in 2022 are in relation to mitigations that were taken following the cyberattack rather than direct costs for remediation of the breach.

2021 (from May 14th)	€42,080,349
2022 (15/07/2022)	€9,795,230.84
