To ask the Minister for Health the number of persons waiting for an assessment of need in counties Cavan and Monaghan; the number who have been waiting less than 3, 3-6, 6-12 and more than 12 months broken down in tabular form; and if he will make a statement on the matter. Pauline Tully

Dear Deputy Tully,

I refer to your recent correspondence in relation to waiting times for Assessment of Need (AON) in counties Cavan and Monaghan. I have examined the matter and the following outlines the position.

The Assessment of Need Officer for Cavan Monaghan has advised that applications are processed in accordance with Disability Act Timelines for AON and they always aim to adhere to those timelines in the processing of applications.

Based on data provided by the HSE National Disability Information Management Hub, 2nd Quarter 2022, there are presently 51 Applications overdue for completion in Cavan Monaghan. Of those 21 (< 1 month); 29 between 1- 3 months and 1 > 3 Months. The following table provides breakdown;
