The Health Service Executive (HSE) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question (PQ 40094/22), which you submitted to the Minister for Health for response.

Please find below a table which outlines the amount of Government funding that was provided under the general medical, medical card, PRSI, treatment benefit, and other relevant schemes, to audiologists, clinicians, and hearing aid providers, for the provision of audiological services including diagnostic, screening and treatment services, and the fitting, provision and maintenance of hearing aids and appliances, cochlear implants, etc., for each of the calendar years 2017 to 2021 and the amount of funding that was allocated to individual practitioners.
