Question: *To ask the Minister for Health if he will provide a copy of any report or reports that have been compiled during an analysis of the energy and heating needs of HSE facilities, particularly care homes and nursing homes; and if he will make a statement on the matter.*

Dear Deputy Brady,

I refer to the above Parliamentary Question which was referred by the Minister for Health to the Health Service Executive for direct response.

The HSE tracks energy usage on an ongoing basis as part of its energy management and reduction programme. The HSE's approach has been to identify and target its efforts on the largest or significant energy users which account for the majority of its energy use and energy related greenhouse gases emissions.

I attach a copy of the energy use of the HSE's largest users in 2021.

The older persons long term residential care units are highlighted (This includes locations where older persons long term residential care units are located within wider campuses also).
