Dear Deputy Crowe

I refer to the above Parliamentary Question which has been referred by the Minister for Health to the Health Service Executive for direct response. I have requested the Assessment of Need office to examine the matter and the following outlines the position.

Below is the Assessment of Need detail by category of assessment:

The Assessment of Need Office has completed a review of all Assessment of Need applications received since 15/01/2020 which may have been affected by the High Court ruling in March 2022. The purpose of this review is to identify requirements for additional clinical assessment under Assessment of Need for each child. If any child requires additional clinical assessment these will be provided based their needs identified in the Assessment of Need process.

The HSE are currently putting assessment teams/resources in place and all recruitment options are being explored including domestic, UK and overseas recruitment to add additional resource to complete outstanding assessments.
