Dear Deputy Sherlock,

The Health Service Executive (HSE) National Ambulance Service (NAS) has been requested to reply directly to you in the context of the above Parliamentary Question which you submitted for response.

The NAS in conjunction with HSE Estates will be making a planning permission submission to Cork County Council with regard to Mallow Ambulance Station in the coming weeks. There was an initial hold up on the site as it was designated as Sporting and a request for purpose change was made and granted Q2 2022.

Final plans for the station were approved in April 2022 and as previously stated planning permission is being submitted for approval in the coming weeks to Cork County Council. Following this stage any progression of this project will be subject to a funding allocation in the future.
