PQ 30535/22: To ask the Minister for Health the number of whole-time equivalent senior podiatrists and whole-time equivalent basic grade podiatrists employed by the Health Service Executive in 2019, 2020 and 2021, in tabular form; the number of those employed by CHO area; and if he will make a statement on the matter.

Dear Deputy Shortall

I refer to your recent parliamentary question in relation to staffing numbers which was forwarded to the Health Services Executive (HSE) by the Department of Health for direct reply.

Employment levels at the end of April 2022, show there were 134,573 WTE (equating to 151,836 personnel), directly employed in the provision of Health and Social Care Services by the HSE and the various Section 38 hospitals and agencies and of which 104 WTE (128 personnel) were chiropodists and podiatrists. Details, by grade for the dates requested by the Deputy, together with the latest available figures (April 2022) are as follows:

I should also point out that in addition to the public chiropody services delivered directly by the HSE; Services are provided by other Providers funded by the HSE through the Chiropody Treatment Card for not only Older Persons but also in particular Diabetic Care, which are additional to the number shown in the above report.

Finally, in relation to Podiatrists and Chiropodist the Deputy will wish to be aware that the Department of Health has recently sanction the creation to two managerial level grades in this area:

- Podiatrist / Chiropodist Manager
- Podiatrist / Chiropodist Manager in Charge III

The HSE conducts a monthly census of public health services employment across all services covering the HSE and Section 38 Voluntary Hospitals & Agencies. The Health Services Personnel Census (HSPC) is the official employment count for the public health sector and is routinely published at https://www.hse.ie/eng/staff/resources/our-workforce/workforce-reporting/.
