**PQ31183/22 Deputy Róisín Shortall- To ask the Minister for Health the total number of antiviral and monoclonal antibody treatments which have been ordered to date; the number that have been delivered; the schedule for delivery for the remaining; the number that have been used to treat Covid-19 patients; and if he will make a statement on the matter.**

Dear Deputy Shortall,

Thank you for your representation.

The total number of antiviral and monoclonal antibody treatments which have been ordered to date are 4,032 doses of Sotrovimab, and 14,000 doses of Paxlovid.

A total of 2,016 doses of the monoclonal antibody Sotrovimab have been delivered. This accounts for half of the 2022 order (4,032 doses). The delivery dates for the remaining doses are yet to be confirmed with GSK. To date, a total of 688 doses of Sotrovimab have been administered across all Hospital Groups.

A total of 5,200 of Paxlovid have been delivered, the delivery dates for the remaining doses are yet to be confirmed with Pfizer. A total of 289 doses of Paxlovid have been distributed to hospitals and community pharmacies in Ireland to date.
